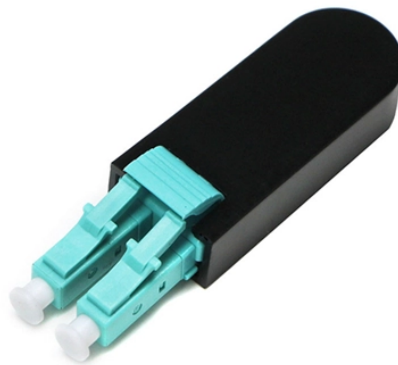
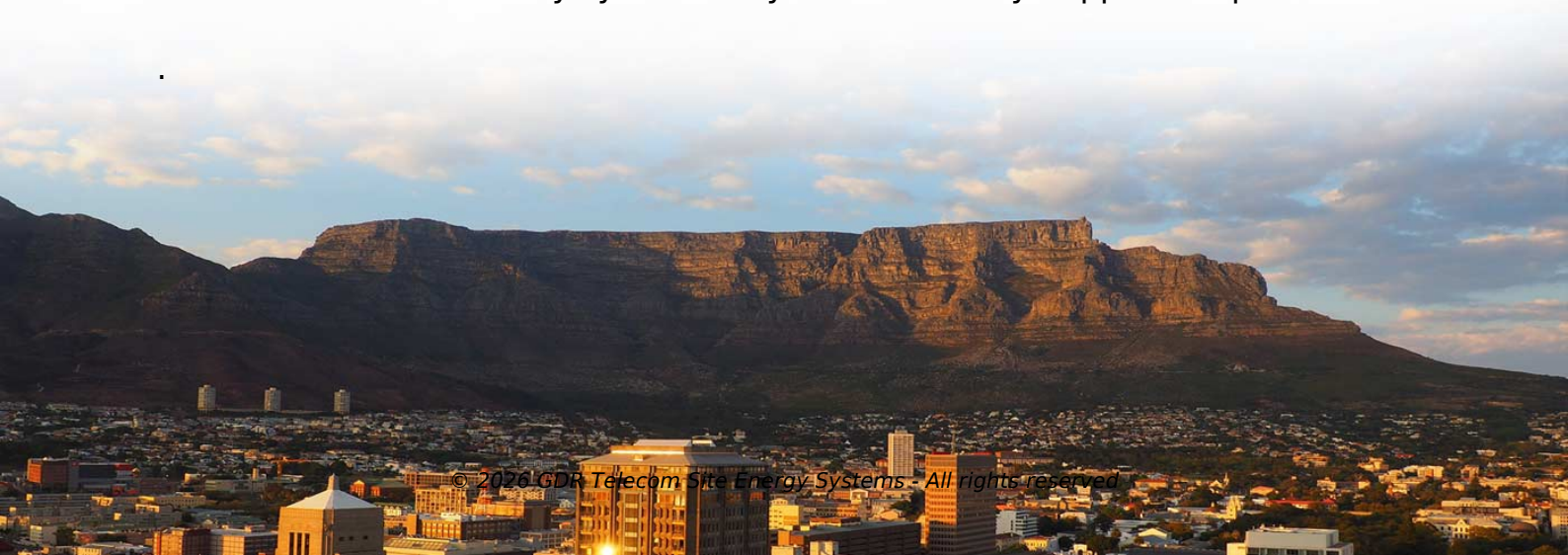


Basic Design of Cable Tray Supports

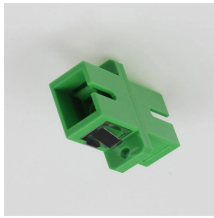


Overview
