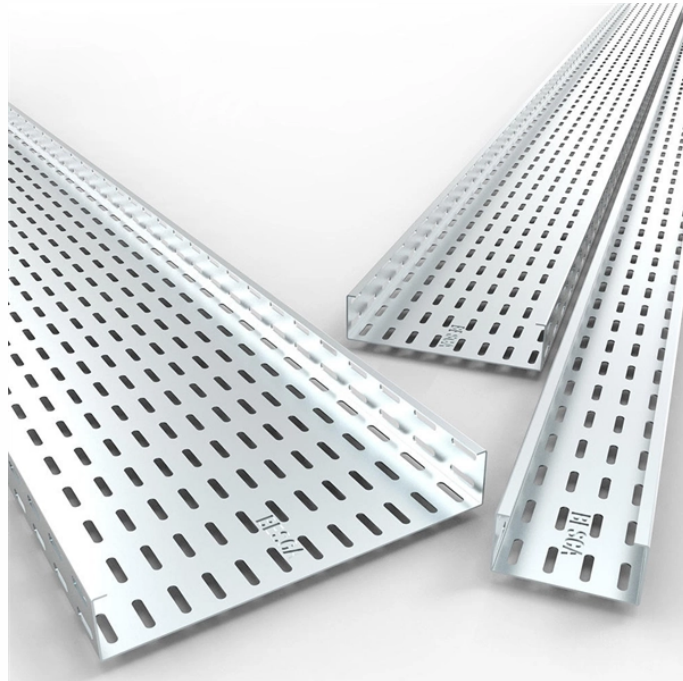


Can I reconnect my broadband fiber optic cable after unplugging it

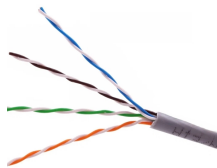

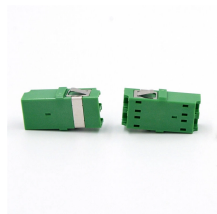
4. Plug the Router Back In Once the modem is fully powered on, plug the router back in. Wait for the router's lights to stabilize, which may take another 1-2 minutes. The router should now reconnect and ...



Make sure you grab the cable by the green piece when removing and inserting it don't just yank on the white cable sheathing. Reinstallation is simply the reverse of what I just described.



Start by physically connecting your router to your modem using an Ethernet cable. This cable should be plugged into the WAN (Internet) port on your router and the other end into the modem.
