The “Land Bridge Chumphon-Ranong” project will develop a deep-sea port on both sides of the sea, worth 1 trillion, with infrastructure linking the transport of goods between each other with a rail system (double-track railway) and a special highway between cities. 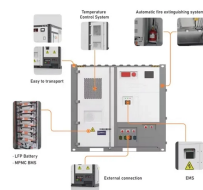
