Overview

Minimum purchase requirements generally obligate a distributor to buy. Labor Code section 2100 by referring to North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) codes. The use of these quotas, however, has come under increased scrutiny from legislators. In 2021, California enacted first-of-its-kind legislation over how certain employers may use workplace.

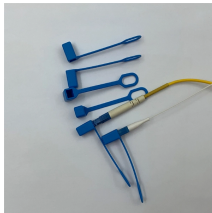
