Overview

Discusses the distribution network within the country from how products enter to final destination, including reliability and condition of distribution mechanisms, major distribution centers, ports, etc. Tajik law provides three options for establishing a legal presence: (i) a representative office, (ii) a branch office, and/or (iii) a legal entity established under the laws of Tajikistan. What works in neighboring countries may not work in Tajikistan, where distribution channels are. The organization of supply chains in Tajikistan is shaped by its geographic location, economic environment, and historical reliance on imports. Our. Infrastructure requirements such as new transmission interconnections can significantly prolong the commencement of trading, given the financial challenges of the country.

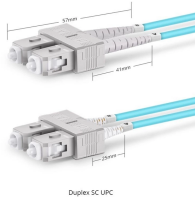
