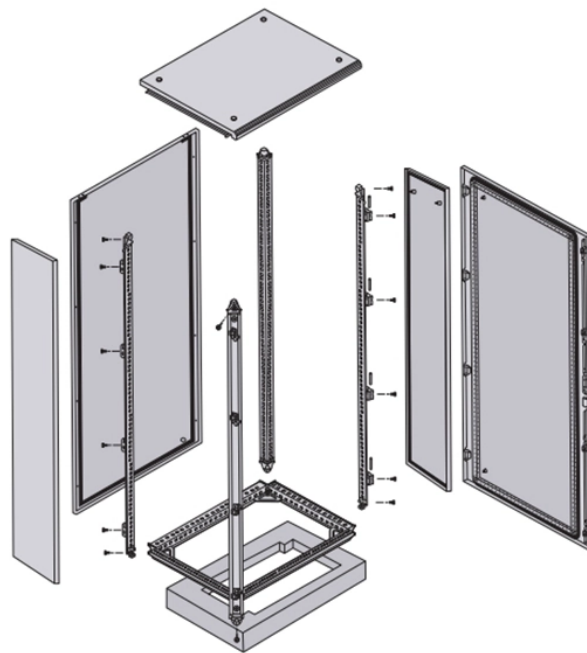


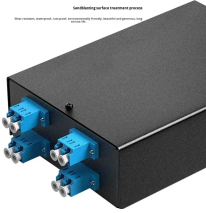

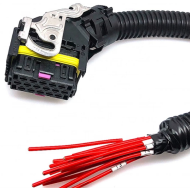
Overview
