Electrician maliciously cuts fiber optic cable



California Penal Code § 591 PC makes it a criminal offense to unlawfully cut, remove, damage, obstruct, or disconnect telephone, cable, electrical, or utility lines.



Once inside, they vandalized an electrical room by cutting or ripping out fiber optic cables used for phone and internet service.



If you intentionally or maliciously cut any telephone, cable TV, fiber optic line you may be charged with Damaging Phone, Electrical or Utility Lines. Potential violations include any unauthorized connection ...



He attempts to cut the line just to one house, but ends up damaging the lines that provide telephone service to an entire street. He could face criminal charges for damaging the phone or electrical lines.



Penal Code 591 PC makes it a crime to maliciously disconnect, remove, injure, or obstruct any telephone, cable, or electrical line. This section can be charged as a misdemeanor or ...



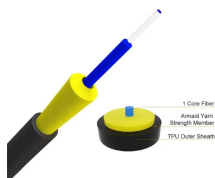
PC 591 of California makes it a criminal offense for anyone to tamper with or maliciously damage, phone utility or electricity cables. Violation of PC 591 is compared to crimes such as vandalism, and a ...
