

Experience in handling excess pigtail length



Overview

Set your stripper to remove exactly $\frac{1}{2}$ inch of coating – too little prevents bonding, while excess bare metal risks shorts. Rotate tools smoothly to avoid nicking conductors. Align stripped wires neatly before twisting. Have you ever spliced the neutral pigtail coming from the afci and gfci breaker because it was too short?

I have, and out of curiosity I looked it up with a couple of manufacturer's websites. It's kind of rough learning these things after the fact. Is this a big deal in your opinion. What would you. 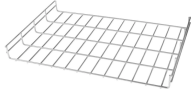
Or do I need to have 6" coming in regardless as one wire then anything pigtailed is extra?

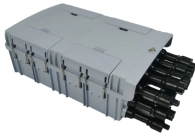

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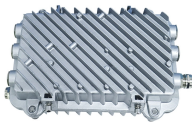
