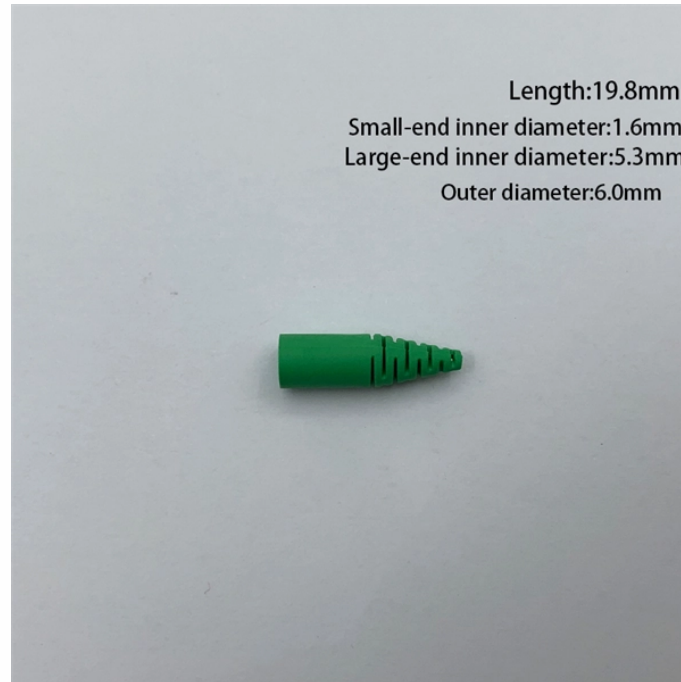


Limin Bridge in the Philippines



Overview

620 meters supported by 43 spans, this extreme bridge spans the San Juanico Strait, the narrowest strait in the country. The bridge connects Tacloban City on the Leyte side and the town of Santa Rita on the Samar. With a total length of 2. This list includes notable viaducts or land bridges built over land mass, on coastal areas, riverbanks and on diversion roads. It is located on Mayor Democrito D. Plaza II Avenue (also known as the Butuan Bypass Road). If you own the work and feel.
