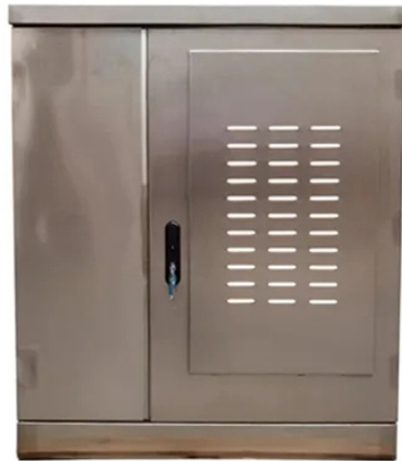


Shen an Bridge Crossing



Overview

The Shenzhen-Zhongshan Link is a bridge-tunnel which connects two major cities on the Pearl River Delta (PRD) in China: the city of Shenzhen on the eastern side of the PRD, and the city of Zhongshan on the western side. 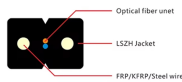

It consists of a series of bridges and tunnels (Shenzhen-Zhongshan Tunnel, Shenzhen-Zhongshan Bridge and Zhongshan Bridge), starting from Bao'an International Airport on the Shenzhen side.



The main section of the \$6.7 billion Shenzhen-Zhongshan Bridge is due to be completed on November 28, 2023. The 24km-long cross-sea route includes a 6.8km underwater tunnel.
