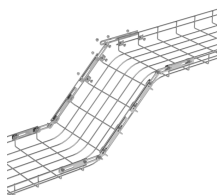
If there is a loose connection or a broken cable, the red Internet light on your router could be on. It is often enough to go over the cable with our chair or to bend it too much, which will be ...
