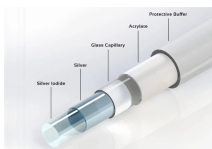

An electrical enclosure is a cabinet or box that protects electrical or electronic equipment (displays, knobs, or switches) and prevents electrical shock or explosions.



To start with, you need to have a label on the outside of the box indicating that it is a high voltage area to warn people not to open it unless they are qualified. In most cases, you also need to ensure nothing ...
