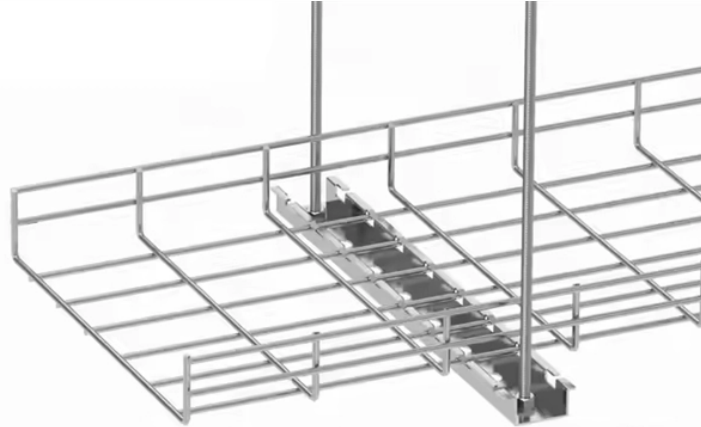

ST fiber pigtail is similar to the FC pigtail, but instead of threads, the ST connector has a locking mechanism different from FC connectors. It has a ferrule with an extended 2.5mm diameter ...

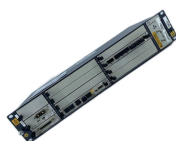
